



Since its founding in 1968, the Land Trust has acquired over 650 acres of open space, comprising 22 properties on which there are 55 trails.


All are invited to enjoy our preserves and trail system, many along the spectacular waterfronts of the Connecticut and Falls Rivers.

The Essex Land Trust's 48-page Trail Guide is a full color, pocket sized booklet featuring detailed maps of all Land Trust properties plus those managed by the Town of Essex and The Nature Conservancy, representing 1100 acres of Town open space. Each property map shows the location of hiking trails and points of interest. A capsule summary of the history and notable

flora and fauna of that property, with pictures and details on location, access and parking, accompanies each property. Property maps are available for downloading from our website. The Trail Guide is free to new members or can be purchased for \$15.00.
